Travelling by Car

Please allows yourself plenty of time hospital parking at it is very limited, charges are payable on exit at the machine for this barrier carpark.

You may wish to use one of the multistorey carparks in the town and take the 10-minute walk or use a bus or taxi for ease on the day.

Directions from the North

Follow the M6 South bound heading for Wigan. At junction 27, Standish, leave the M6. Get in the left-hand lane of the slip road and take the A5029 which is the first left turn off the roundabout at the top of the slip road.

You are now on a dual carriage way for approximately 600 yards. Keep left. At the end of dual carriage way, you reach a junction, turn Left for Wigan (A49). You are still on the A5029 and are heading for Wigan town centre. (At this point you can also follow signs for Haigh Hall Country Park as they will take you the same destination).

Continue on the A5029 going straight through the first set of lights until you reach the second set of traffic lights at Standish Village. At these traffic lights turn right onto the High Street, heading for Wigan on the A49.

Continue along the A49 following signs for Wigan town centre. Eventually you will come to a small roundabout (Boar's Head Pub). Go right at this roundabout and continue along the A49 for approximately two miles going straight through a mini roundabout. If you stay in the left-hand lane on the roundabout, you will have priority to pass. Eventually you will arrive at the Royal Albert Edward Infirmary which is on your right



continue past the hospital to Freckleton Street carpark which is the second turning on your right.

Directions from the South

Follow the M6 North bound heading for Wigan. At junction 25 leave the M6. Get in the left-hand lane of the slip road. At the roundabout take the first exit (left), following signs for Town Centre, A49. Continue on this road for approximately 400 metres (past a retail park on the left) until you reach the next set of traffic lights, you will need to get in the right-hand lane. At these lights turn right onto the B5238/Poolstock Lane. Continue on this road for approximately 2 miles. After crossing a mini roundabout turn left at the traffic lights following the B5238/Chapel Lane. Continue on this road following Chapel Lane through 4 sets of traffic lights.

At the 5th set of lights you will come to a T junction signposted A49 Preston/Standish. This will also be marked on the road lane (there will be a large hotel on your right-hand side and a Snooker Hall directly in front of you). Bear to the right at this junction again, staying in the left-hand lane marked A49, following the sign A49/Preston. You will start picking up the signs for the Hospital at this junction. At the next set of traffic lights go straight through (you will see a Tesco on the left) joining Central Park Way and going up the hill, again following the A49. This bends to the right and joins Wigan Lane. Carry on up the hill for approximately just under quarter of a mile turn left onto Freckleton Street and second right to access the carpark.

Traveling by public transport


Trains:
