

Swansea Bay University Health Board Singleton Hospital Sketty Lane, Swansea, SA2 8QA

By Car

From East, M4 motorway to Junction 42, exit onto A483 towards Swansea/Abertawe and continue for 0.7 miles before merging onto the A483. In 0.4 miles, keep left on the A483 and merge onto Fabian Way/A483. Continue for 3.3 miles where you will continue onto Quay parade/A4067. Continue on the A4067 for 2.5 miles until you turn right onto Sketty Lane/A4216. Take the first right into the Hospital grounds.

From West, M4 motorway to Junction 47, take the A483/A48 exit to Swansea (W)/Abertawe (Gn)/Gorseinon. At the Penllergaer Interchange, take the 4th exit onto A483. After 1.5 miles, take the 1st exit at the roundabout onto Pontardulais Road/A483 and continue for 1.4 miles. Turn right onto Station Road/A4216 and continue for 1.3 miles. Turn right onto Vivian Road/A4216 and continue for 0.6 miles. Turn left onto Sketty Park Road/A4216 and continue for 0.2 miles. At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Sketty Lane/A4216. At the traffic lights, take a left turn into the Hospital grounds.

By Train

Swansea is a popular destination and there are direct trains from a number of cities including Cardiff, London and Bristol, as well as regional connections from Carmarthen, Llanelli, Shrewsbury and Pembroke Dock. There is a taxi rank immediately outside the station. Transfer to the hospital take around 15 minutes. The High Street bus stop is a 1 minute walk from the train station (turn right on exiting the train station).

By Bus

Bus Service 4 – Singleton Hospital – Morriston Hospital via Liberty Stadium – First Cymru (transfer takes approximately 30 minutes) from the High Street Station. Usually buses run at 13 minutes, 28 minutes, 43 minutes and 5 minutes past the hour. Return journeys leave the Swansea University Campus, Singleton (5 minute walk from the Clinical School) at 30 minutes and 45 minutes past the hour. Car Parking

Visitors are advised to park in the South Car Park which is located at the bottom of the map. As you turn right into the hospital the car park will be on your right hand side. Allow yourself plenty of time to secure a space in readiness for your exam. Car parking is free but there is a 4 hour maximum stay in operation. Visitors expecting to be longer than this will need to register their car details on an iPad located in the main entrance foyer. There are disabled parking bays at the front of the South Car Park but there are also bays to the front of the hospital.

Refreshments

There are two coffee shops and a canteen on site at singleton Hospital where refreshments may be purchased. Please see the mind attached where refreshment areas are identified by a coffee cup.

Examination

The examination will held in the Computer Room in the Library at Singleton Hospital, number 20 on the map below. Take the stairs at the main entrance to the first floor and turn right for the library (volunteers at the main entrance will be available to direct you however). The Pathology Clinical Training Manager will act as invigilator and will be on site half an hour before the start time of the examination.
