If you are travelling to Queen's Hospital by train, the closest station is Romford, which is part of TfL now running services on the **Elizabeth Line**. The hospital is a 10 minute walk away. Buses 128, 175, 193, 365 and 496 run between the hospital and the station.

Car

Car access to Queen's Hospital is through the main entrance on Rom Valley Way. If you are travelling by road via the M25, take junction 28 (A12), then the A125 or Junction 29 (A127) then the A118 to Romford town centre. Follow the signs to the hospital.

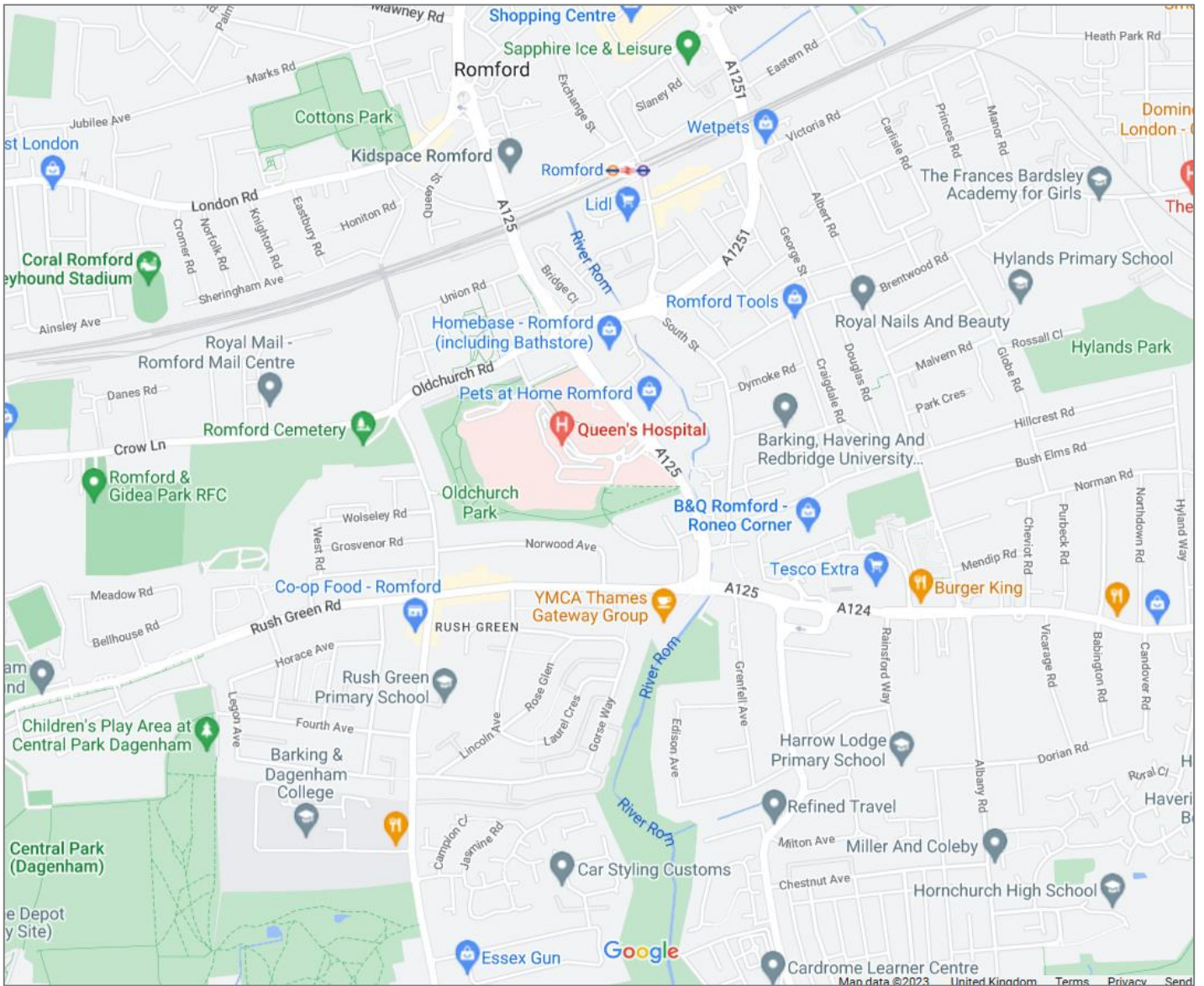
Multi-storey car park

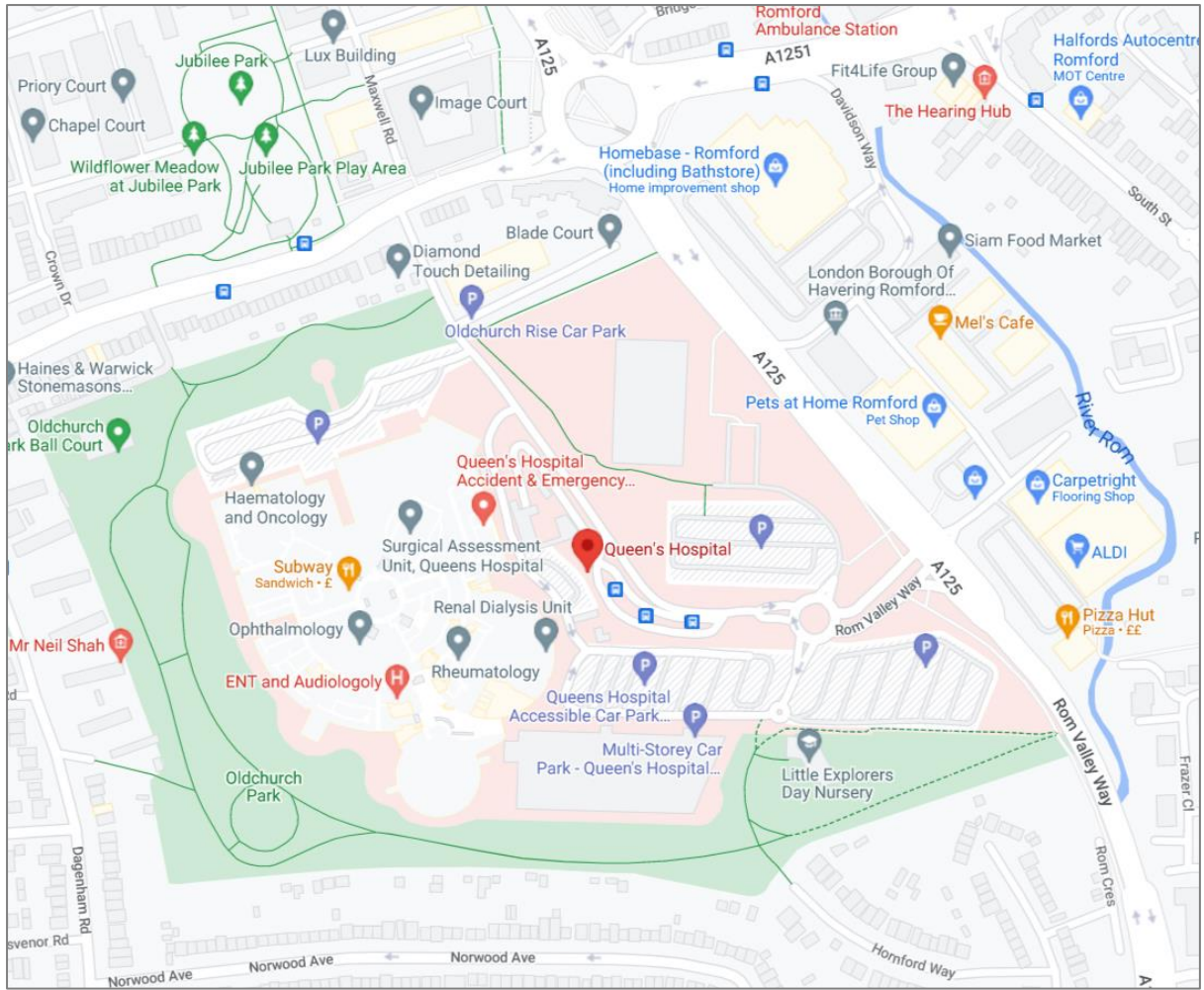
From Friday 26 August, the multi-storey car park will be operated by automatic number plate recognition (ANPR). The entry barriers will rise when your number plate has been recognised and you won't need to collect a paper ticket on entry.

Patients and visitors can park on the ground and first floor, and designated area of the second floor of the multi-storey car park.

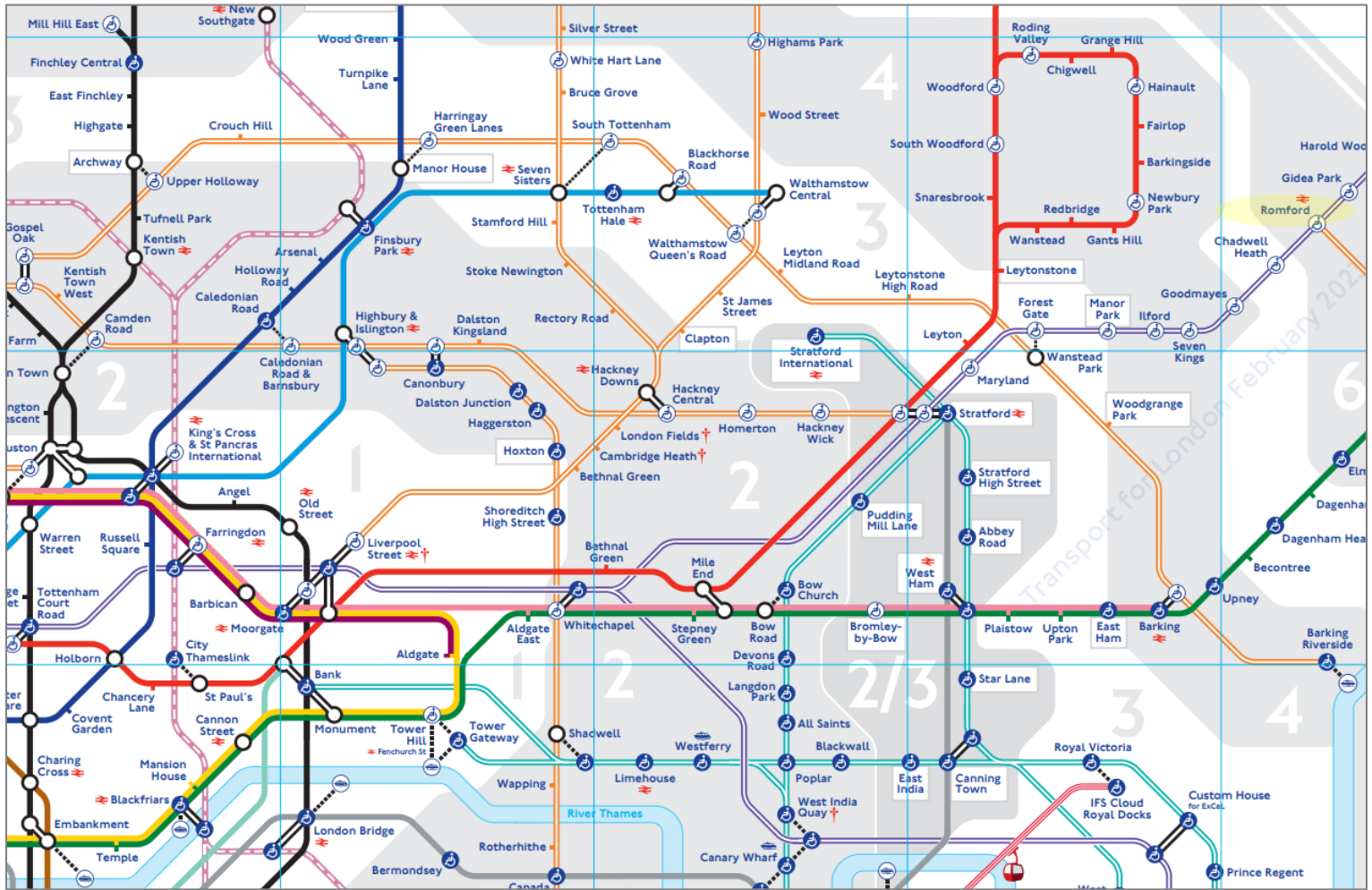
When you leave the hospital, pay your tariff at the machines located between the main entrance and the car park. If you don't pay, the exit barrier will not let you out.
